

## Security Officer Training

**Executive Summary:**

This program includes training in industry specific required certifications and skills knowledge to enter the Security Officer industries listed below:

**Industries:**

Government Contractors, Public Offices, Financial Institutional, Educational Campuses, Private Correction Facilities, Construction Industry, General Industry, Electric Utilities, Gas and Oil Industries, Industrial Industry, Remediation, Timber Industry, Pipeline Industry, Plumbing Industry, Chemical Industry, Environmental Industry, Waste Management Industry, Natural Gas Pipelines, Drug Manufacturers, Hazardous Waste, Remediation Industrv, etc .
